Treasures in the city	• Item (e.g., neon signs, trams, junk boats) • Place (e.g., dai pai dong, an ecological site, sports and leisure facilities) • People/Skill/Craft (e.g., traditional noodle making, mahjong tile carving, tai chi) • Message (e.g., respect for grandparents, cherishing unique skills, connections to values)
Street interview-style questions	• If you could add one thing to your school, what would it be? • What can you teach someone in ten seconds? • Which everyday invention deserves an award? • What made you smile at school today? Preferences: • Explore outer space or the deep sea? Why? Challenges: • Describe a mystery object without using its name.
Deeper questions	• Can you be brave and scared at the same time? • What can adults learn from students? • What would you like to be known for? • What has a mistake taught you? • How would you make a new student feel welcome? • What everyday science mystery would you like to solve?
Literacy-related questions	• Which fictional character would make a great classmate? • Which book deserves a film adaptation? • What is something that a book taught you?
