

PDNETwork for English Teachers: Online Workshops by Topic Area





Topic area descriptions

Topic area	Description
Assessment literacy	Understanding the theory and practice of assessment
Catering for learner diversity	Addressing the diverse needs of different student groups
Curriculum planning	The design of school-based lessons and programmes
e-Learning	Open flexible learning mode involving use of electronic media
Grammar	The teaching of grammar at text level
Information literacy	The ability and attitude that enable students to use information effectively and ethically
Language arts	The creative use of English language (e.g. drama, poetry)
Literacy foundations	The introductory workshops required of teachers new to the NET Scheme
Pedagogy	The art and science of teaching practice, including teaching strategies.
Phonics	The teaching of letters and sounds for language
PLPs	Primary Literacy Programmes of the NET Section (PLPs may require different workshops)
RaC	Reading across the Curriculum (across knowledge disciplines)
Reading	The teaching of decoding and comprehension strategies
Self-directed learning	The skills where learners take the initiative and responsibility for learning, with or without assistance
Speaking and listening	The teaching of oral and aural skills
STEAM	The learning experiences and opportunities that apply science, technology, engineering, arts and/or mathematics concepts and skills in an integrated way
Thinking	Models, theories and approaches that enhance students' ability to problem-solve, create and critique in language contexts
Values education	The teaching of positive values and attitudes to prepare for the challenges of current and later life
Vocabulary	The study of words
Writing	The teaching approach of process writing
