



Gorilla PD has a new name and a new home: “PDNETwork”



Are you signed up?

The NET Section has migrated our online workshops from **Gorilla PD** to our own dedicated platform, **PDNETwork**, powered by the same suite of technology: Gibbon and Free Learning. <https://nets-pd.edb.edcity.hk/>

Going forward, you need to be signed up to the new platform. Your existing history of completed workshops has been migrated to PDNETwork (unless you did not complete the task sent to schools prior to the migration).

How do I know if my Gorilla PD data has been migrated to PDNETwork?

If you acted on the NET Section request to update your **Gorilla PD data**, you will have received a confirmation email.

If you did not do this task, you can check your details on the new PDNETwork site: <https://nets-pd.edb.edcity.hk>

- Find the workshops you have completed.
- Open the “Enrol” tab in the workshop.
- Check if your history is recorded (e.g. pending, complete, [approved](#)).

Please note that data for Gorilla PD workshops not created by the NET Section (e.g. *Welcome to Gorilla PD*) will not be migrated. However, it will remain on Gorilla PD.

If you cannot see your data, please contact us.

Should I continue to use Gorilla PD?

No, that platform will no longer host the NET Section online workshops. Please use the PDNETwork platform from now on.

How do I register for PDNETwork?

If you were registered to Gorilla PD, that account has been replicated to the new *PDNETwork* platform. So you will be able to use the **same username** and **password** on *PDNETwork*.

What if I have forgotten my password?

If you have forgotten your Gorilla PD password, go to the “**Log in**” box on *PDNETwork* and click on “**Forgot password?**”. A new password will be sent to you by email.

What email address should I use?

You must be registered with **your school email address**. If you are currently registered under a different email address, add your school email address as your “alternate email”. You can find how to update your information here:

Go to the top menu item “**People**”

- Data updater
- Data updates

Find your name. 

Click on the pen icon.

Scroll down to “**Contact information**” → Find “**Alternate email**”.

Ensure one of the email addresses is your school email.

Change this when you change schools.
