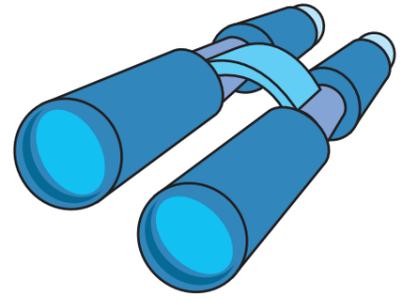


Skim and Scan
