PLP-R/W and KIP schools


Two older versions of the literacy programmes, PLP-R/W (P1-3) and/or KIP (P4-6) continue in many schools.

- PLP-R/W – Primary Literacy programme – Reading/Writing (mostly co-taught by LET and NET in English and GE rooms)
- KIP – Key Stage 2 Integration programme (often taught by LETs in their GE room)


CPD for PLP-R/W and KIP – LETs and NETs




