

NET SECTION LEARNING HUB SPEAKING TO WRITING (S2W) "EXPERIENCE SHARING"

On 5 June 2025, the Speaking to Writing (S2W) Learning Hub conducted its fourth and final event at the NET Section office in Tsuen Wan. Following on from professional development provided by the Dyslexia-SPELD Foundation (DSF) Australia, as well as the chance to network at the 'Planning Lab' event, teachers were invited to share their experiences of engaging with this approach.



The event was designed in such a way that participants were exposed to the experiences and practical considerations in a variety of modes. These included keynote speeches, micro presentations, table sharing and ample opportunity to network with other teachers. Whether participants had been engaging with the process for a long time, or were taking their first steps, this design supported development at all stages. The variety of sharing formats focused on authentic teaching experiences and addressed the challenges that participating schools had experienced - as well as the ways in which these were overcome.

In order to 'bookend' the content of the Learning Hub, scratch cards were used as a vehicle to both initially communicate concerns (elicited during Event #1, in November 2024) and then, finally, to reflect upon these concerns in groups.



Participants particularly appreciated the concise presentations, opportunities to network and the sharing of authentic classroom footage. Interacting with other teachers at table sharing was a more unstructured and informal way of exploring new ideas. Participants used a reflection sheet to collect inspiration and good ideas as a record of their favourite takeaways from the event. The team look forward to future events!
