

- Started with English Ambassadors
- Individual presentations
- Group presentations
- Final team + Bonus child (Understudy)
- Good synergy and complementary strengths



Strategies

- Let them talk! (Teachers listen and take note)
- It's not IMPROV! (Student-led, teacher-guided)
- Encourage natural speech and mannerisms ("Yeah, bro")
- Student ownership of script/PPT
- Practice, practice, practice!





E-Learning

Practice Makes Progress




