

How to make a Wooden Spoon Puppet



What you need:

- Wooden Spoon
- Wool
- Marker pens (to create facial features)
- Coloured cardboard

Cut 20 pieces of wool about 10cm long




EDB, NET Section

Cut another small piece of wool.
Tie it in the middle

Stick double-sided adhesive tape
on the top of the spoon.
Attach the hair

Trim the hair with a pair of scissors.

Use marker pens to create facial features.





Facial feelings

Think about how the feelings will change in the story. Two feelings per spoon.

Costumes and props.

Colour the templates and then push the spoon through the hole.

Stage Platform

Backdrop Hanger

Cut a piece of wool to stretch across the top of the theatre.

Fold and add backdrops here or a piece of fabric.

Title Plate

- Title plate with the name of the play should be stuck to the front of your puppet theatre
