They run about the house at night.



Flies


I see some flies

Poor little flies!



They always **fight**,











Dolphins

This old dog saw a bone,


Saw a bone behind a stone.

Drops the hoe,







A Toad in a Boat

Wearing a red coat.



Encourage students to tap/clap the beat.


Friendly Dragon
