Celebrating Values in Education

MA ON SHAN LING LIANG PRIMARY SCHOOL

The school shared how P1 students explored empathy through a CAA-style journey from cognition to action. Through stories like Grumpy Monkey, songs, and reflective ranking activities, they shifted from understanding “our feelings” to caring about “their feelings.” The unit concluded with a Kindness Promise poster that reinforced daily acts of kindness.

The teachers shared how P3 students analysed moral traits through fables, sequencing tasks, and Venn Diagram comparisons. They strengthened real-world connections by applying these traits to people they admire. A touching highlight was when students showed heartfelt empathy and encouragement toward a classmate in need.

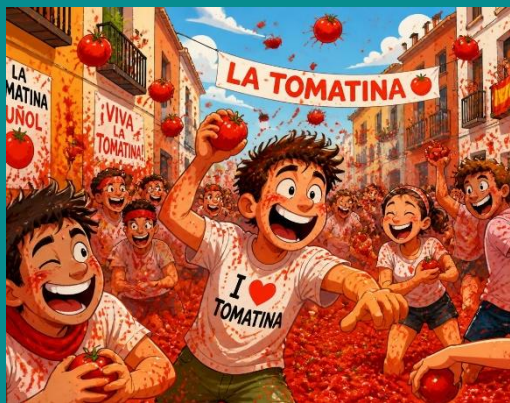
The school shared how they embedded values education into co-taught English lessons, supported by whole-school promotion. Through engaging stories and authentic classroom experiences, students practised respect, empathy, care, responsibility, and national identity in meaningful and age-appropriate ways.

Across levels, learning was thoughtfully connected to real life. P1 and P2 students explored empathy and community belonging through stories, role-play, and take-home activities, while P3 – P6 students reflected on local Hong Kong contexts using “I Agree / I Disagree” discussions, quizzes, and goal-setting to strengthen diligence and perseverance..

The school shared how the P3 unit promoted empathy and responsibility through a creative festival theme, “The New La Tomatina!” Students engaged in story-based acting and diary writing, strengthening grammar skills while reflecting on food waste issues.

Learning deepened through an EPD talk and NGO partnership, followed by role-play reporting and a 5W1H redesign task to ensure “You cannot waste food.” Students created leaflets with practical tips, presented their ideas through structured interviews, and concluded with a thoughtful Diamond 9 reflection.
