Experiential Learning in Values Education

EVENT OVERVIEW

Our second Learning Hub event provided a fantastic opportunity for participants to showcase the promotion of values education in schools and share classroom resources.

Participants engaged with creative tools and activities designed to make values tangible and memorable for students of all ages.

THE LEARNING HUB CHRONICLES

LEARNING APPROACH

The major focus was on experiential learning — helping participants feel, practise, and reflect on values rather than only learning about them in theory.

This hands-on approach ensures educators can authentically incorporate values into their teaching practices and create meaningful learning experiences.

CREATIVE TOOLS & ACTIVITIES

Chinese calligraphy and calligrams were used as creative tools to explore themes such as respect, empathy, patience, responsibility, and integrity. This activity encouraged participants to slow down, concentrate, and connect their actions to the values being practised.

Turning art-making into a hands-on learning experience allowed educators to see how mindful creative practices can help students internalise important values through focused, intentional work.



CALLIGRAPHY ACTIVITY

Participants practised Chinese calligraphy to explore values like respect and patience. The slow, deliberate brush strokes helped connect actions to the values being learned.



COMMUNITY PHOTOGRAPHY

Participants captured meaningful moments through photography, writing captions to explain values such as kindness, responsibility, and cooperation in everyday settings.
